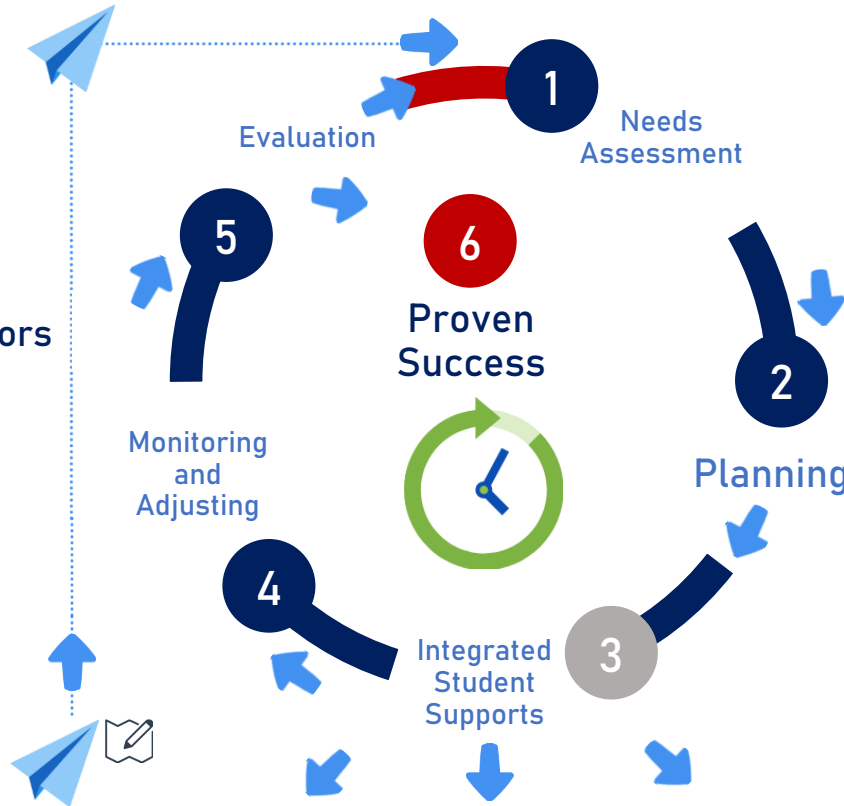
Learning Support Teams



Learning Supports
Supporting our schools and working with the educator ambassadors, our teams will promote teachers who are leaders in the classroom and understand the vision to grow communities by assisting various functions, systems and school structures. Our teams will organize, train, and help mobilize partners to provide resources.

School Community Coordinators
Trained educators who coordinate with school and district administrators, school community leaders, teachers, parents, and key community stakeholders to assess needs, develop models and plans to provide levels of support for students and families.

Our Community
Schools, community stake holders, and businesses all correlate together with elementary schools, coordinators, and school community leaders to deliver supports to students and families.



- 1 Needs Assessment**
Analyze multiple sources of data to identify the key needs of the school and individual students. Survey staff, parents, and students. Determine the current pipeline of services to address community needs.
- 2 Planning**
School Community Coordinators lead their school support team to develop a plan to prioritize supports that address leadership, literacy, and STEM to provide opportunities for students. Provide coordination of community services to increase access to families in need.
- 3 Integrated Student Supports**
School Community Coordinators, Leaders, and partners deliver tiers 1,2, and 3 of support to the schools, students and families. Provide Summer Enrichment Academies and systems of support in PBIS/MTSS structures.
- 4 Monitoring and Adjusting**
School Community Coordinators continuously monitor analysis of program outputs with early childhood programs, school and out-of-school time, transition programs, family and community engagement, workforce readiness, community-based needs, and SEL learning.
- 5 Evaluation**
Continuous improvement assessment of partners and student supports by the Learning Supports teams, Project staff, and the evaluation team to demonstrate results and improve practice. Reflection on data analysis collected through advisory teams.
