Increase of behavior events in 2018-2019, despite a decrease in total enrollment from 2016-2017 and 2017-2018
(increase of 4,103 behavior events – 4.7%)

Number of students with 11-20 events 3,824 (4.2% of student population)

Increase of In-School Removal from 2016-2017 / 2017-2018 / 2018-2019 with Black (+9,744 increase), Hispanic/Latino (+3,695 increase), and other (+2,624 increase)

Behavior Incidents by Location – Classroom 80.0% for 2018-2019

Behavior Events Involving Assault and Violence – increase of 2,220 events with whites (900 up to 3,120), increase of 521 events with blacks (816 up to 1,337) increase of 499 events with other (148 up to 647)

Males up 2,609 events / Females up 631 events

Grade levels with highest events – 6,7,8,9, and 10

Economically Dis-advantaged up 2,558 events (1,513 up to 4,071)

Increase of behavior events involving weapons (403 up to 676)

Drugs, Alcohol, or Tobacco (9,966 up to 20,795 events) over a period of 3 years (+10,829 events)

Tobacco with 16,364 events (78.7%) / Marijuana second highest with 13% 2,708 events

Bullying or Harassment 2016-2017 (14,876 events) / 2017-2018 (13,626 events) / 2018-2019 (17,410 events)

Males 12,627 / Females 4,783 (2018-2019)
